Payroll Giving for wage and salary earners.

You can donate money to the new community pool directly from your pay. Your employer will make the donation payment to the Bruce Community Facilities Trust for you. You don't have to spend a lot to support your community. A small regular donation over the next two years adds up to a huge difference.

You will need to give your employer:

- The name of the organisation Bruce Community Facilities Trust
- Our bank account number (0609 390216509 00)
- · How much you want to donate each pay
- How often you want to donate, for example one-off, every pay, every other pay your employer may have their own rules for this.
- We anticipate the project being completed by the end of 2027.

What happens when you get paid

Your payroll provider will calculate your donation and take it out of your wages before they pay you.

Your tax credit of 33.33 cents for every dollar you donate is reimbursed at the same time.

For example: On an M tax code if you decided to give \$25.00 per pay, the actual amount deducted would be \$16.67 – the deductible tax of \$8.33 is automatically credited back.

Claiming end of year donations

You will not get a receipt when you make a donation through payroll giving. You cannot include the payroll giving donations in your end-of-year tax credit claim, as you've already received the tax credit.
